If possible, walk or cycle, or go by car.



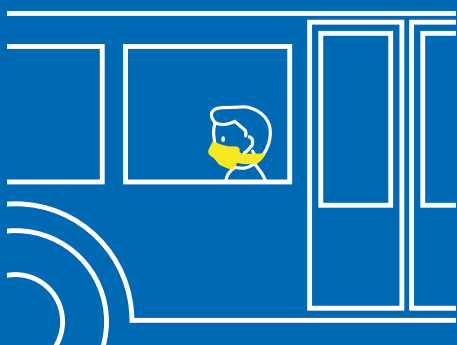

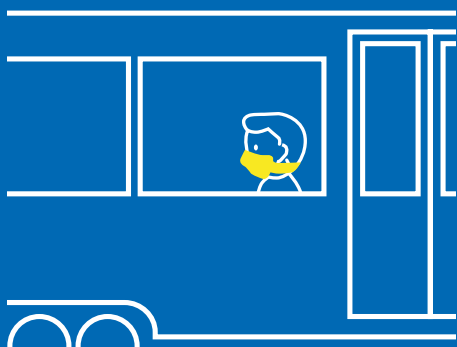
New rules on face coverings



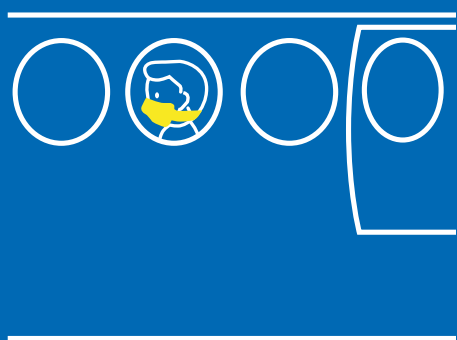
From 15th June if you need to use public transport you should use a face covering.

Travelling on trains and trams.

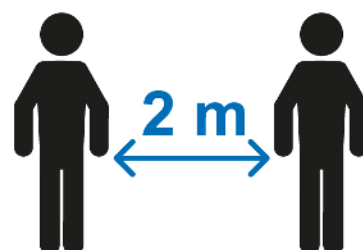


Travelling on aircrafts and ferries.

Bus travel guidance

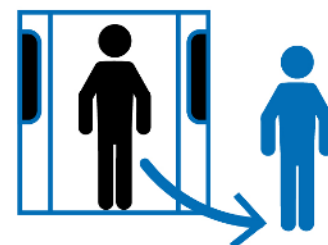
Stay safe

Keep 2m apart from people not in your own household while waiting

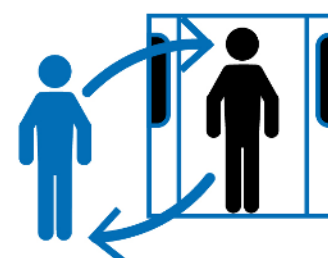


Look out for 'bus full' signs

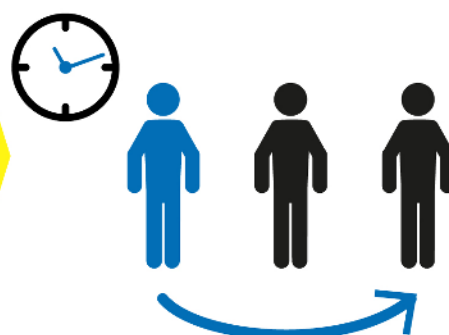
The bus will only stop when people want to get off or if there is enough space onboard



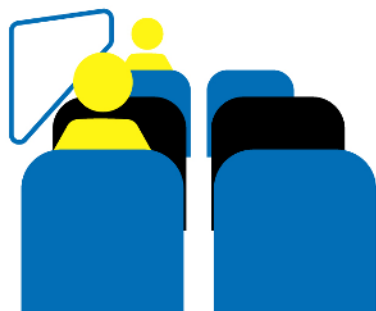
If they do stop, they will normally only be able to let one passenger on for each one that gets off.



Be prepared to wait and please help others by prioritising those who need to travel more urgently than you

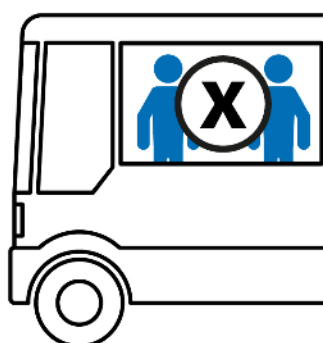
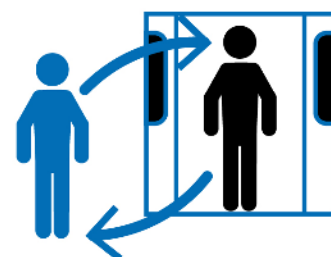


Help keep our buses safe



Take a window seat, avoid standing and leave space in front and behind you.

Please be patient and wait for passengers to get off before you board a bus



Do not stand or queue in the aisle or next to the bus driver

If you can, wear a face covering where social distancing isn't possible.
