KEY INFORMATION FOR OUR ELECTRONIC PLATFORMS:

* **Our website** is at www.bridgewaterhigh.org and contains most of the information you should ever need about the school in general, including news and forthcoming events.



- * **Arbor** is a very important app (or website) for parents and carers. Through Arbor you can:
- View your child's daily timetable
 - See your child's attendance, behaviour and lesson scores data in real time
 - Change your phone number, address and contact information

As our use of the app grows over time its functionality will hopefully also include receiving messages from school or accessing your child's school reports and other assessment data. Invites to access Arbor will go out to parents/carers in September.

* Our homeworks are all to be found **Satchel One** (formerly known as Show My Homework, on website and app). The username and password for this will be the pupil's email address (see below) and usual password used when logging into a school computer (this will be given to pupils in September). You can also have a parent code to keep track of homeworks separately yourself.



* **Pupil email addresses** are our recommended method for pupils to communicate with teachers (they can also send messages via Satchel One). Their email address is their usual school log-in (e.g. 25smitha) followed by @bridgewaterhigh.com – example = 25smitha@bridgewaterhigh.com. To get started, pupils will simply need to visit www.office.com and click Sign In. They should then log in using the email address mentioned above (e.g. 25smitha@bridgewaterhigh.com) and their usual password used when logging into a school computer. Pupils could also download the Outlook app to achieve this.

* Finally, **Office 365, now entitled the Microsoft 365 Copilot app**, (accessed as above) allows access to many other online apps such as Word, Excel, Teams, OneDrive (for saving work online) etc. All pupils can also download and install up to five copies each of Office 365 for use throughout their duration as a Bridgewater student e.g. onto a laptop. This is achieved by selecting **Install Apps** after signing in and selecting Apps (top-right of the screen).
