Dear Prospective Parents/Carers,

I would like to take this opportunity to clarify the details of the Induction Days **Wednesday 1st** and **Thursday 2nd July 2026** and the Parents' Information Evening **Thursday 2nd July 2026**.

The pupils should come in their primary school uniform and meet in the Lower School Hall before 9.00am on the Wednesday. Thursday is a full school day and so pupils will need to arrive by 8.40am at the latest and go straight to their form room (they will know which room this is by then). They will be participating in P.E. on one of the days, but we will not know which day until we reveal which band they are in on the Wednesday. As such, they will need to bring appropriate footwear, shorts, and t-shirt on the Wednesday just in case.

Pupils will also need their pencil case, and either lunch money or a packed lunch. For those opting to have a lunch in school, they should bring £5.20 which will cover **both** days and will be collected on day one. This will entitle them to a main meal and a drink or a cookie. For break time they will need a maximum of £1 per day with which they can choose from a variety of snacks (this will be handed straight to the till each day) Pupils entitled to a free school meal will be provided for.

Both days will finish at 3.00pm where parents can collect their children at the end of Hall Drive, or they can wait in the Lower School Hall to meet with any siblings currently in Year 7 to go home with them.

On the evening of **Thursday 2nd July**, parents and carers are invited to Lower School. Doors will open at 6.00pm where items of school clothing can be viewed.

From 6.30pm there will be short presentations from the Principal, Mr Powell, and Ms Mitchell, the Head of Year 7. There will then be the opportunity to meet with Form Tutors and members of Education Support Team.

Could I remind you that Hall Drive does become congested, and that parking is available by following the one-way system into the school grounds and following the parking signs. Due to the large numbers invited to this evening, I ask that youngsters be left at home.
